**ALL DANCING EVENTS WILL BE HELD UNDER
THE RULES OF THE SOBHD**

1. Any protest must be submitted in writing to the Chairpersons of the Highland Committee, properly signed and accompanied by a fee of \$20. If protest is sustained, fee will be returned. Protests must be made immediately following posting of results.
2. Communication with a judge, piper, or scrutineer in respect to a competitor, will result in disqualification of that competitor.
3. The Committee reserves the right to change any event or time schedule.
4. All dancers must be registered with FUSTA in order to dance and must present 2011 FUSTA registration card in order to receive prizes.
5. Beginner dancers will not receive a stamp on their card for either the Lilt or Flora. Prizes will be awarded but no stamp.

NAN DALEY HIGHLAND DANCE PAVILLION

6. ROBERT LYALL LOWE

Open to all dancers who have **not** reached their 7th birthday and are **California residents**. Contestants must be able to complete 4 steps of the Highland Fling. Competition will take place after the Primary Sword Dance.

7. CITY OF EDINBURGH MEDAL

To qualify for the **City of Edinburgh Medal**, dancer must win a 1st prize in the Juvenile or Junior Fling, Sword or Seann Triubhas. The dance will be drawn from one of these 3 dances. Total aggregate points of the judges will determine winner. Dance will take place immediately following posting of results.

8. THE DALEY DOUBLE

To qualify for the **Daley Double**, a dancer must win a 1st, 2nd, or 3rd place in any of the Sunday Premier events or the Saturday Jigs and Hornpipes. Premier 7 & under 16 will dance a **4-step Blue Bonnets for the New Steveston Village Memorial**; the Premier 16 & over will dance a **4-step Highland Laddie for the Motherwell Town Memorial**. **SET STEPS FOR THESE TWO DANCES WILL BE ANNOUNCED AT THE COMPETITION**. Both events will take place at the conclusion of the Highland Laddie and prior to results being announced.

NOTE

Proof of registration (competitor number) must be presented at the gate for admission.

9. Competitors may only compete in events to which their respective birth date applies. **Saturday Regional Championships, age as of July 15th, 2011**. Premier Jigs & Hornpipes, age as of May 28th, 2011. All dancers on Sunday, age as of May 29th, 2011.

DANCE STEPS

10. **Beginners/Novice:** Fling 4 steps, Sword 2 & 1, Seann Triubhas 3 & 1. Lilt 4 steps, Flora 4 steps.
Intermediate: Fling 6 steps, Sword 3 & 1, Seann Triubhas 4 & 2, Barracks Johnny 4 steps.

ALL JIGS: 3 & 1

ALL HORNPIPES: 4 steps

PREMIER SUNDAY NATIONALS: All 6 steps

AGGREGATE TROPHIES

11. Aggregate trophies will be given to all Pre-Premier classes, except Primary (inclusive of all 4 dances). Aggregate trophies for Premier Nationals will include Jigs and Hornpipes on Saturday and all Nationals on Sunday combined.

PRIZE MONEY

12. **JIGS & HORNPIPES (4-step dances)**

Premier 16 & under 18: 1st - \$30, 2nd - \$15, 3rd - \$10

Premier 18 & over: 1st - \$65, 2nd - \$50, 3rd - \$30

If there are 6 or more dancers in 16 & under 18, a 4th prize of \$5; 6 or more in 18 & over, a 4th prize of \$15 will be added.

SUNDAY NATIONAL EVENTS (6-step dances)

Premier 16 & under 18: 1st - \$50, 2nd - \$25, 3rd - \$15

Premier 18 years and over: 1st - \$100, 2nd - \$75, 3rd - \$50. If there are 6 or more dancers in 16 & under 18, a 4th prize of \$10; 6 or more in 18 & over, a 4th prize of \$25 will be added.
